the nights truly a time for nightmares. Who can wonder that sight of some unscheduled isle, where the ship perforce dropped anchor, was hailed with delight? It was restorative to get one's land legs again. And there was always the possibility that the traveller might find some use for such a phrase—carefully mouthed in atrocious Greek: "Beautiful maiden, come and sleep with me."
