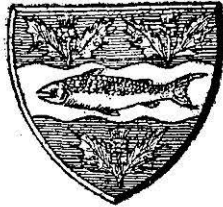


NOVA SCOTIA

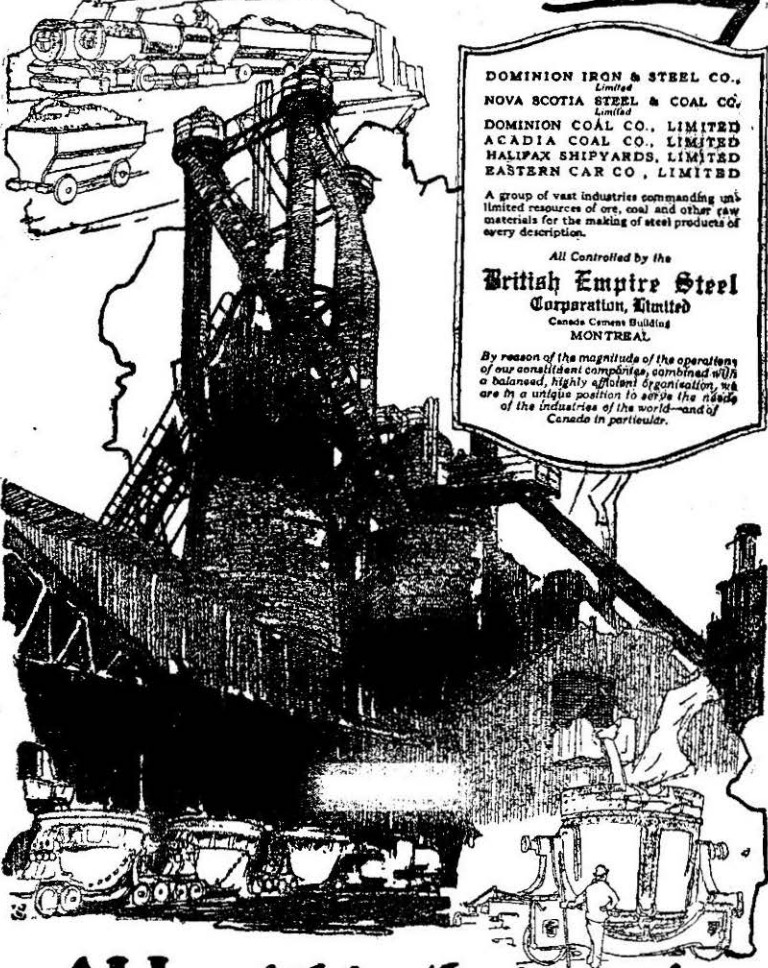
