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A Glimpse at Canada Place **EXPO '86**

Canada Place as designed by the joint venture of Musson Cattel & Partners, Downs/Archambault and Zeidler Roberts Partnership/Architects will be the home of the Expo '86 Canadian Pavillion. Subsequent to the exposition Canada Place will be converted into Vancouver's Trade and Convention Centre.

This massive complex, 139,350m2 (1.5 million square feet) is well underway with a completion date of April, 1986. The lowest level will provide a loading area for cruise ships and parking for 800 cars. A terminal located above the parking floors can service five cruise ships. The Convention Centre with 9,300m2 of display area is above the cruise ship level. A 500 room hotel and 23,225m2 World Trade Centre sits atop the Convention Centre.
