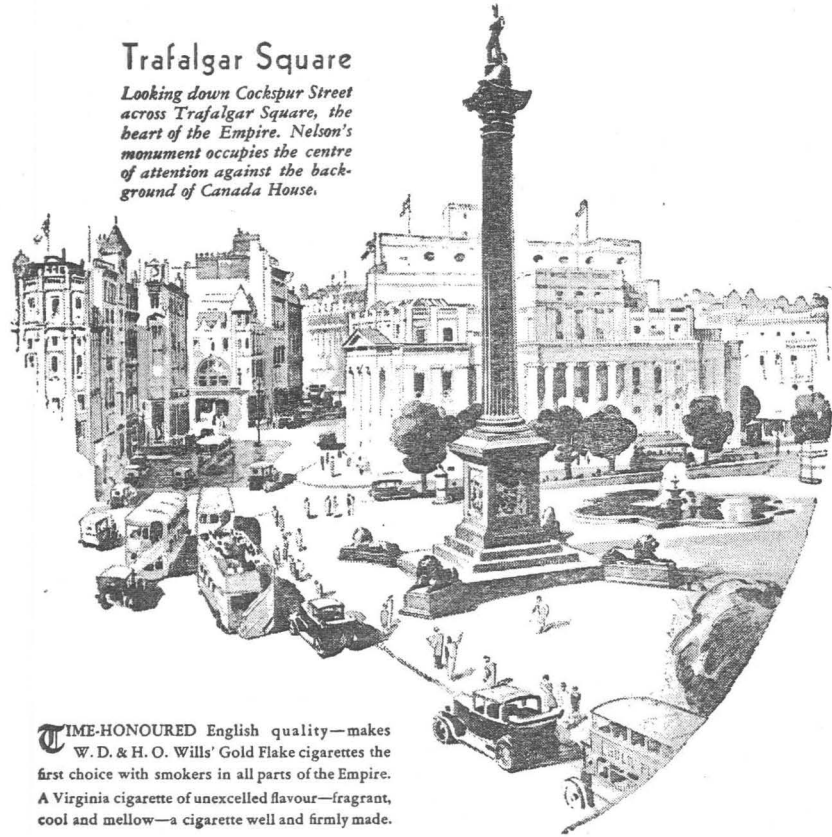

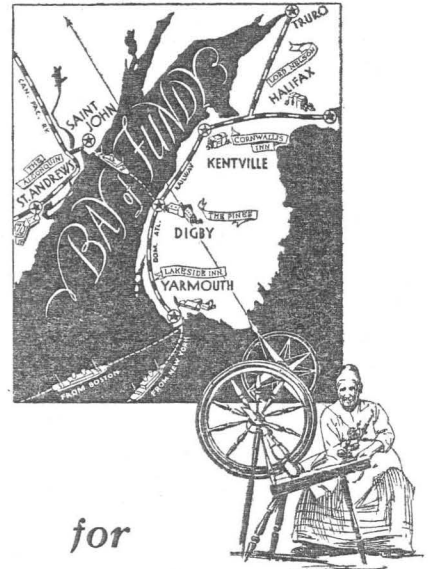

Special Scholarships awarded to Pictou Academy, Prince of Wales College, and Memorial University College, St. John's, Newfoundland.

**First, Second and Third Year Scholarships:** These scholarships vary from \$255 to \$100, and are awarded on the results of the University examinations of the respective years.

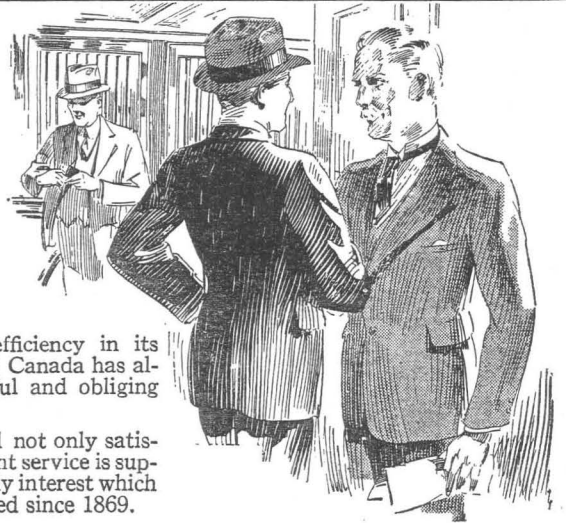
