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## Secretion in Erwinia chrysanthemi

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## Abstract

*Erwinia chrysanthemi* which is a causal agent of soft rot disease produces pectinases, cellulases and proteases. These enzymatic activities are secreted in the culture medium.

Pleiotropic mutants of *Erwinia chrysanthemi* were shown to affect the secretion of pectinases and cellulase across the outer membrane, demonstrating that this bacteria possesses a specific transport system for these enzymes.

We are investigating the secretion mechanism in *Erwinia chrysanthemi* using two approaches:

- 1. Study the region(s) in the sequence of one pectinase gene which are necessary for its transport outside the cell.
- 2. Characterization of the genes (at least three) which are implicated in the transport system.

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
