Robert Lyons Comeau, former Chair of the Department of Economics, died on April 4, 2003, in the QEII Health Sciences Centre, Infirmary site, after a brief illness. He was 76.

Born in Kentville, he was the son of the late Desiré A. and Alice M. (Lyons) Comeau. He earned a BA and an MA from St. Francis Xavier University. Later, he received a PhD from Brown University. After completing his education, he taught economics at Boston College, Carleton University and the University of New Brunswick. For 27 years, he taught at Dalhousie University, where he served as Chair of the Department of Economics. He was also President of the Dalhousie Faculty Association. A social activist, he campaigned particularly for workers' rights and for medicare. He was active in his local church, St. Thomas Aquinas Parish, and the Catholic Social Services Commission.

He was pre-deceased by his sister, Rosalie Marie (Hummie) Beazley Hicks.
