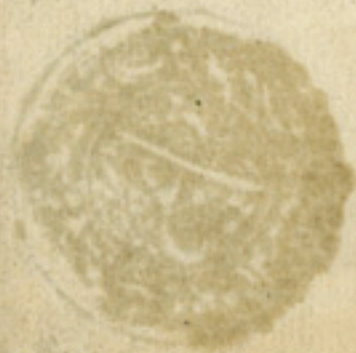


James Schmitt's Son



To James Finlay Esq

By Virtue of a Receipt issuing from and under the hands and Seals of the Governor General and Council of Fort William in Bengal, unto me directed, you are hereby required to come before The Honourable Sir George Ailans Burslow, Baronet the Governor General at the Presidency of Fort William in Bengal, The Right Honourable General (Guad Lord Lake, George Medley Esquire, and John Lumsden Esquire), Counsellors at the said Presidency, of Fort William in Bengal aforesaid, Justices of our Sovereign Lord the King assigned to keep the peace in and for the Town or Factory of Calcutta and the limits thereof and also to hear and determine divers Felonies, Trespasses, and other Misdemeanors committed in the said Town or Factory of Calcutta at Fort William in Bengal and the limits thereof, on Tuesday the twenty fifth day of February instant at the hour of ten of the clock in the morning of the same day, at the Court house at the Sessions of the peace to be then and there held and then and there to enquire present, do, and perform all and singular such things as on behalf of our said Sovereign Lord the King shall then and there be enjoined you, given under my hand and seal this seventh day of February, one thousand eight hundred and Six.
