## Telephoning To Out-of-Pro- vince Friends Need Not Now Cost You So Much.

---

A recent decision of this Company should prove specially satisfactory to those who have friends resident in North America outside of this province, with whom they like to have an occasional chat.

The decision, which became effective on December 1st, was to adopt into this Company's practice the Standard Classified Method of quoting rates on calls to points on this Continent outside the bounds of Nova Scotia.

Person-to-Person service, the class of service to which telephone users in this province have hitherto been restricted, is still the highest grade of service we furnish, and the new method also provides for Messenger and Appointment Service—forms of Person-to-Person Service.

The new system is now universally effective on this Continent for international and interprovincial business and has met with a cordial reception. The result of the brief experience of its operation in Nova Scotia indicates that it will be received with equal favour by this Company's customers.



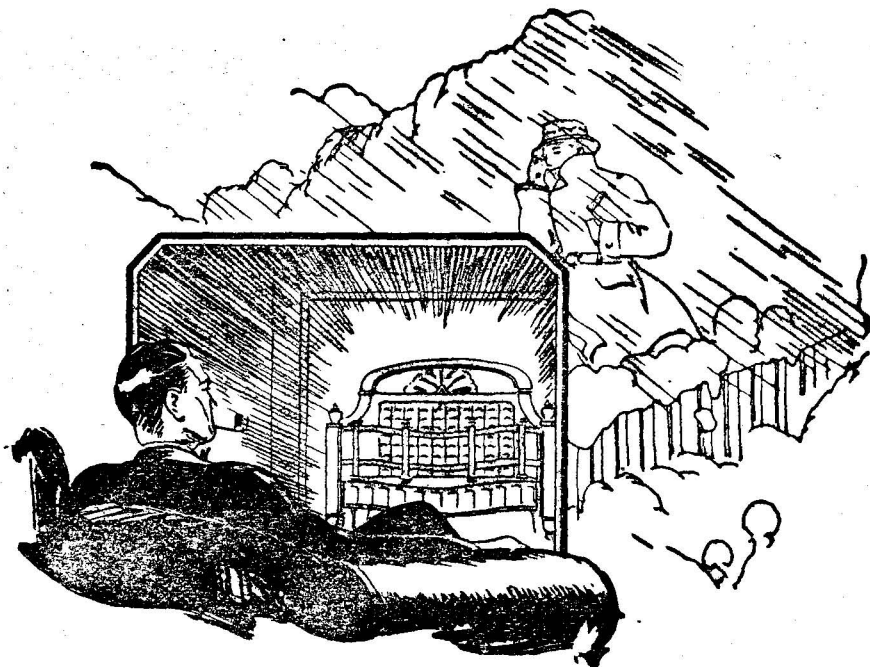

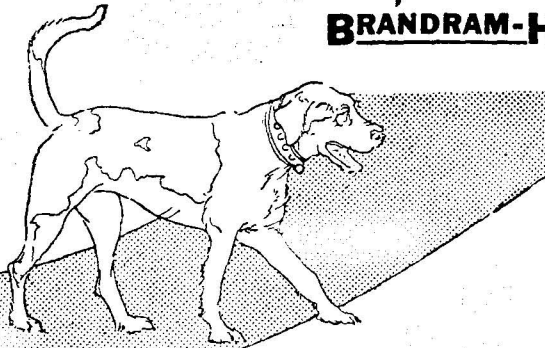
