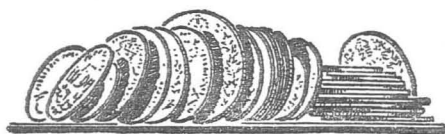
**MORE ABOUT NOVA SCOTIA.** By Clara Dennis.

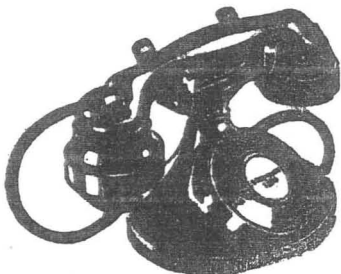
