Dr. Helena (Heli) Munroe was an occupational therapist who was a faculty member and Acting Director in the School of Occupational Therapy at Dalhousie University in the late 1980s. Dr. Munroe passed away from complications of Alzheimer's Disease on Monday, June 15, 2009 at the Bellingham Grange Hospital in England at the age of 66 years. Ironically, Dr. Munroe's expertise was in dementia, combining her occupational therapy background with a PhD in psychology. After leaving Dalhousie University, she joined the occupational therapy faculty at The Robert Gordon University in Aberdeen, Scotland. Dr. Munroe will be greatly missed by her family, friends and colleagues.
