In Memoriam - Norma Lynn Thompson

It is with great sadness we announce the passing of Norma Lynn Thompson, daughter of the late Murray and Loretta Thompson, which occurred on Friday July 22nd, 2016 (age 48) at the Victoria General Hospital in Halifax. Norma was born November 6th, 1967 and grew up on the family farm in Carsonville, New Brunswick.
