Key Activities:

- SRMG met four times: September 20, November 26, January 11, May 31
- SRMG continued the pre-approval process for license renewals on the System-wide Electronic Access Fund (EAF), reviewing upcoming licenses in September 2021, November 2021, and May 2021.
- During the summer of 2021, the Libraries responded to faculty input and concerns related to the
 planned cancellation of Web of Science, providing alternate database options such as Scopus and
 subject-specific databases. In December 2021, the Dal Libraries notified CRKN that the Libraries
 would not be renewing the Web of Science license. Subsequently during the Winter 2022 term and
 to date, there have been no major user concerns expressed about the cancellation.
