

Agreement between my
Sister Jane, and John
Brook

I do acknowledge that I
have taken for you that part of
the farms of Hethland which I
now possess of you for 33 pounds
sterling of yearly rent and for a lease
of nineteen years from and after
the 25th day of 10th June. I bind my
self to pay the rent in equal portions
half yearly throughout the term
of the lease, from the exact time of
beginning. I also bind my self
to plough and harrow the two
acres which you have reserved to
your self, and to lead your dung to
it, and give it what work it needs
throughout the lease. I also bind my
self to lead you ten cart loads of
peats from Heston, each year through
out the year lease, and likewise to
pay the road money, and all other
public burdens that may be laid
on the farms at any period of the
lease. I will observe the same rate

in the present of the year
that are pointed out to the rest of
his ^{years} servants, and this shall shall
be extended on stamp paper if
when you require it.
