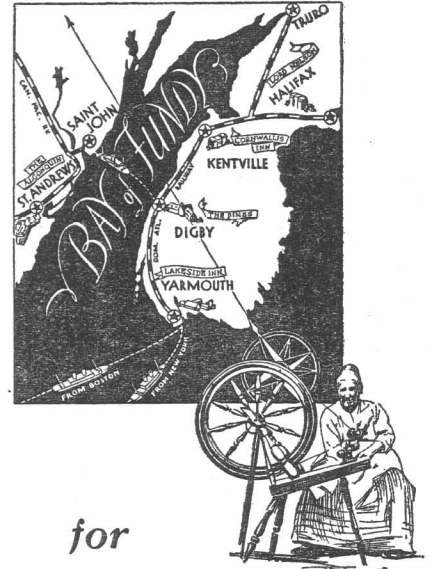

First, Second and Third Year Scholarships: These scholarships vary from \$255 to \$100, and are awarded on the results of the University examinations of the respective years.

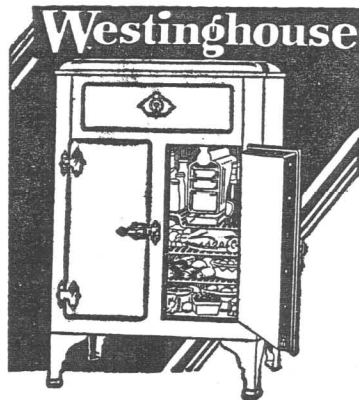
