Key Activities:

- SRMG met seven times: July 14, September 18, November 27, January 7 & 18, February 18, May 3.
- During the year, the COVID-related transition to online teaching created a pressing need for additional electronic resources. SRMG considered a range of ebook packages, streaming video collections and other items for purchase. Most of the selected products (though not all) were acquired using one-time carryforward funds and included the following:
