Poor Richard, villain, hunchback, murderer, has been unearthed. His bones lost for 400 years

after the battle of Bosworth Field until archaeologists plotted the site

of GreyFriars, dissolved by that Tudor who killed his wives, rather than his nephews.

DNA tests confirm it is Richard, killed August 22, 1485.

King for only two years, he was challenged by Henry Tudor, Senior, Welsh upstart,
